DAY-BY-DAY ITINERARY

Day 1

Following disembarkation from your Azamara ship in Istanbul, enjoy a guided visit to Beylerbeyi Palace. Built between 1863 and 1865, it overlooks the vast waters of the Bosphorus and impresses with its gardens and mansions. Enjoy a local lunch, then transfer to the airport for your flight to Cappadocia. After checking in to your hotel, take time to relax and refresh before regrouping this evening for dinner at the hotel.

Please Note: As Beylerbeyi Palace is closed on Mondays, this will be replaced with Yıldız Palace. Flight between Istanbul & Kayseri is subject to change which could impact your itinerary

Day 2

After breakfast, visit the Red Valley and explore its famous rock-cut churches. Then, visit Çavuşin village with its rock-cut dwellings and stone houses. After lunch, drive to the Pigeon Valley. Visit Underground City, constructed around nearly one hundred tunnels, it's one of the most interesting underground settlements in Cappadocia and at one time could accommodate thousands of people. Here, visit a carpet cooperative, where you'll see how exquisite Turkish carpets are hand-woven. Following your fabulous day in Cappadocia, you will drive back to your hotel. Then, get ready for an amazing evening of Turkish culture in a local cave restaurant. Take in a bride and groom dance, folk show and belly dancers, over dinner and unlimited drinks. Overnight in Cappadocia. Note: Tour order may vary.

Day 3

After breakfast, check out of your hotel before your tour to explore the almost-Martian landscape in the Devrent (Imaginary) valley. Visit Paşabağ's 'fairy chimneys', carved by nature over thousands of years. From here, visit Avanos Center of Terracotta Art with its attractive old town with cobbled streets and lovely river views. Stop by a ceramic and tile center to see how local ceramics are made and try pottery for yourself. After lunch, visit the famous Göreme Open Air Museum to see the best examples of Byzantine art in Cappadocia. Complete the tour with a panoramic view of the valleys of Cappadocia. Transfer to the airport for your return flight and overnight in Istanbul. Dinner is on your own this evening.

Day 4

After breakfast, check out of your hotel before transferring to the airport for your journey home.

Modest attire is required during mosque visits; knees, shoulders, and midribs must be covered, and women must cover their head with a scarf, which will be provided by Blue Mosque and Hagia Sophia.
